Sequel to the approval of the Chairman to the resolutions passed by the State Affiliation Committee in its meeting held on 20.06.2017 in the Conference Hall of JK BOSE Bemina Campus Srinagar, sanction is hereby accorded for grant of extension in the period of affiliation/Upgradation in favour of 121 Educational Institutions for a period of five(05) years . The details of the Institutions are reflected in the list enclosed as Annexure "A"(107 Extension cases) and Annexure A1(14 upgradation Cases) to this order. However, this order shall be subject to the following conditions.

- A. The affiliation shall strictly be governed by the terms and conditions as laid down vide SRO 123, relevant Govt. orders, BOSE regulations and the resolutions of the State Affiliation Committee meetings passed from time to time.
- B. That the minor deficiencies listed in the joint inspection report/s, reflected in the said annexure against each institution are to be addressed within a time bound period of three months. The compliance to this effect will be monitored by the joint re-inspection teams as and when required .
- C. There shall be no compromise with safety conditions, therefore three mandatory Statutory Certificates viz Building safety, Fire Safety, and Chemical Safety by the designated authorities are essential for the consideration of the affiliation and the institutions concerned shall be required to submit renewed certificates immediately after expiry of the validity period of said Safety certificates besides the compliance to NBC(National building code) norms are to be ensured .
- D. It shall be binding upon all the Institutions to fulfill all the statutory conditions laid down from time to time.
- E. The financial transactions especially the payment of salary to the Staff is to be made through Bank.
- F. Fee structure to be adopted by the Institutions must strike compliance to the decisions of Fee Fixation Committee constituted by the Govt. in pursuance to the directions of the Hon'ble High Court.
- G. All schools have to comply with the conditions mentioned in the NOCs by the competent authorities .In particular they shall comply with the NOC conditions imposed by the Traffic Department for the safe transportation of Children's , boarding/De boarding arrangements of Children and deployment of the personnel for the purpose.

- H. The heads of the affiliated Institutions shall keep their infrastructure like the Examination hall and related facilities at the disposal of the BOSE as and when needed and especially at the time of the examinations.
- I. The Academic calendar prepared by the BOSE is to be strictly adhered to. Any deviation thereof will invite imposition of penalty.
- J. It will be obligatory to stick strictly to the curriculum adopted by the BOSE for all classes and prescribe Books published by the JKBOSE for transaction the Curriculum proper arrangement for co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for the students must be ensured.
- K. To maintain hygiene and sanitation, separate Toilets have to be there for boys and girls. An additional facility of Change room is to be made available to the Girl students with first Aid facilities.
- L. Parent Association as required under Norms has to be there to ensure joint monitoring along with Managing committee for the Academic development of the Students and the Implementation of the decision that are being taken for their further improvement.
- M. The EFP/CPF (whichever is applicable) is to be maintained with the required contribution towards the fund.
- N. It shall be obligatory upon all the affiliated academic Institutions to obtain recognition Order from School Education Department.
- O. In addition to the above, the Inspection of the Academic Institutions will be caused on yearly basis and the above period of affiliation shall be reviewed annually on receipt of Inspection reports.


The observance to above mentioned requirements is obligatory and any deviation thereof will invite penalty, even de-affiliation from JK BOSE.

Subject: Affiliation issues of Schools-extension of period thereof.

Circular No: 02-JK(Edu) of 2026
Dated: 31.03.2026

Whereas, vide Circular No. 06-JK(Edu) of 2024 dated 19.09.2024, one time exemption was granted to all those schools which are without a valid affiliation, both for the earlier academic session 2023-24 (when they were tagged with the nearby government school) and academic session 2024-25, for non-conformity to provisions of SO 177.

Whereas, further, JKBOSE was directed to extend all board related facilities viz; Registration Return (RR) forms, eligibility, migration, and examination to such schools for sessions 2023-24 and 2024-25, for classes 9th to 12th; and

Whereas, vide Government Order No. 1703-JK (GAD) of 2024 dated 04.10.2024, a committee was constituted to examine the cases of Private Schools which does not fulfill the conditions as laid down in S.O 177 and number of representations were received and forwarded to the Committee for examining and recommending the cases as per the mandate of the Committee.

Whereas, vide Circular No. 07-JK (Edu) of 2025, Dated 13.08.2025, extension was granted upto 31st March, 2026 to all private schools of UT of J&K, who have not been able to fulfill the conditions laid down under SO 177 of 2022 dated 15.04.2022 and this spell of period is likely to expire; and

Whereas, the Committee constituted vide Government Order No. 1703-JK(GAD) of 2024 dated 04.10.2024 has not yet finalized/submitted its report/recommendations. The mandate of the Committee is to examine the applications so received on case to case basis as per the extant rules in UT of Jammu and Kashmir; and

Whereas, keeping in view the academic needs of the students, the terms and conditions issued vide Circular No. 06-JK(Edu) of 2024 dated 19.09.2024 is required to be further extended for another period of one year upto 31.03.2027, enabling them to obtain provisional affiliation with

JKBOSE, wherever required and also fulfill other requisite formalities necessary for registration and appearance of students in the relevant examination.

Now therefore, the terms and conditions as laid down in Circular Instructions No. 06-JK(Edu) of 2024 dated 19.09.2024 is hereby further extended, till 31st March, 2027. Further, it is enjoined upon the Committee constituted vide Government Order No. 1703-JK(Edu) of 2024 dated 04.10.2024, to expedite/furnish the recommendation/report, at an earliest, without any further delay, so that a holistic and wholesome decision is taken in the matter.
